

PBA HISPANIC PASTORS' GATHERINGS

New Ministry Proposal for Approval
Sponsored by the Pasco Baptist Association
Submitted by: Trevor Holloway, Ph.D.

Purpose

To provide a monthly gathering for Spanish-speaking and bilingual pastors focused on fellowship, biblical teaching, prayer, leadership development, and ministry resources, strengthening both pastors and their churches within the Pasco Baptist Association.

Need

Many Hispanic pastors experience isolation due to:

- Language barriers
- Bi-vocational ministry demands
- Limited access to leadership resources
- Weak connection to one another and to PBA

This ministry will build community, encouragement, and practical support.

Ministry Structure

Frequency: One Saturday per month

Includes:

- Fellowship & relationship building
- Teaching on relevant ministry topics
- Group prayer & encouragement
- Resources for pastors and churches

Locations: Churches, homes, or restaurants (potluck or catered)

Additional Elements:

- Wives invited
- Extended gathering times
- One annual marriage & ministry retreat

Annual Focus Topics (Summary)

- Pastoral health & burnout prevention
- Bilingual & bicultural church leadership
- Culturally relevant preaching
- Discipleship models in Hispanic contexts
- Developing lay leaders
- Church health & next generation engagement
- Conflict resolution
- Fellowship gatherings & retreat

Budget Request (Annual)

Total: \$7,400

- \$2,400 Facilitation stipend for Pastor Trevor Holloway at \$200/month
 - \$5,000 Ministry resources (meals, books, training, pastoral support)
- All budget will come from the existing PBA Ministry line item

Funds stewarded in consultation with the PBA Executive Director.

Regional Participation

- Up to 15 non-PBA pastors may attend annually at no cost
- Additional participants may require all outside PBA to contribute to offset expenses

Expected Outcomes

- Stronger unity among Hispanic pastors
- Healthier pastors and families
- Increased leadership capacity in churches
- Greater engagement with PBA

Motion for Approval

Approve the launch of the PBA Hispanic Pastors' Gatherings and the annual budget of **\$7,400** as outlined.
